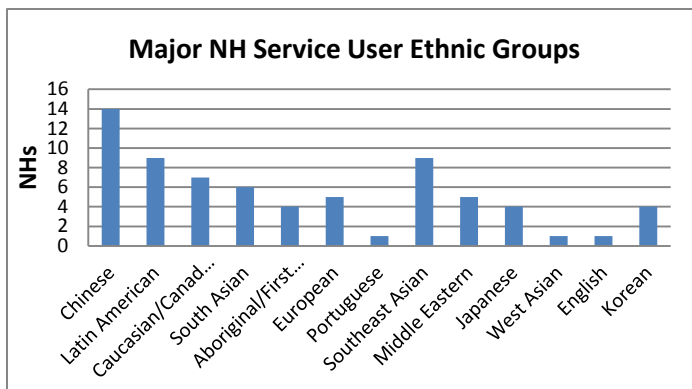

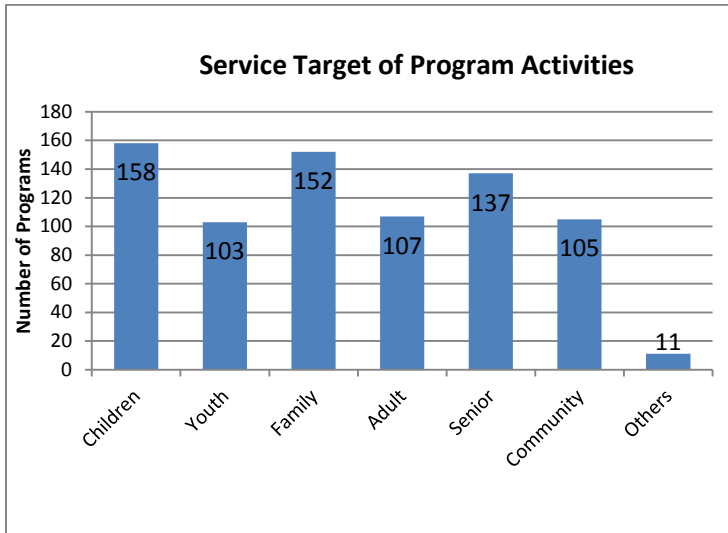
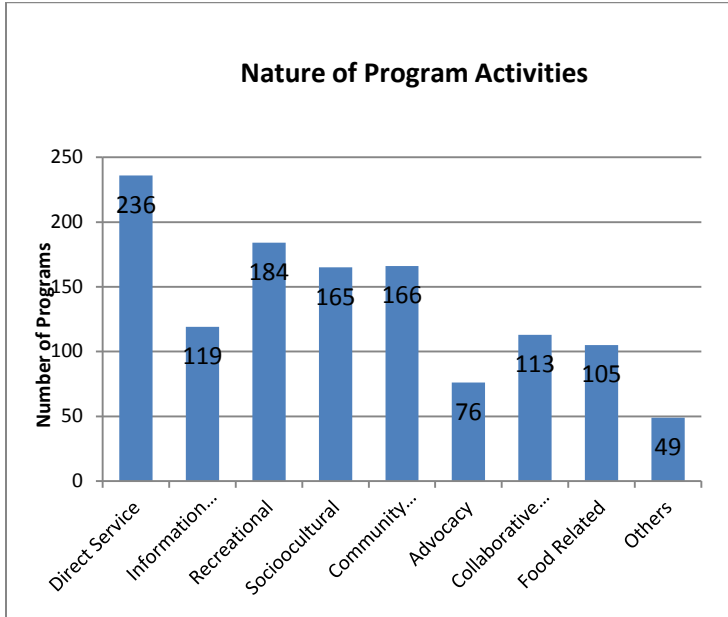

4. Top Five Ethnic Groups among Service Users

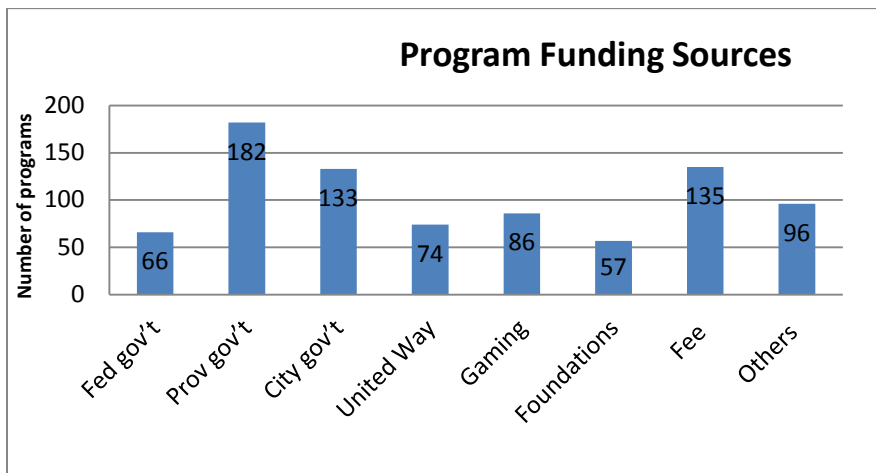
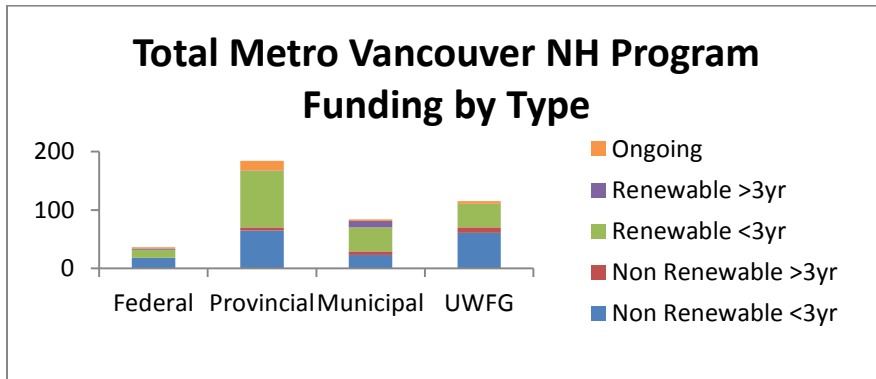
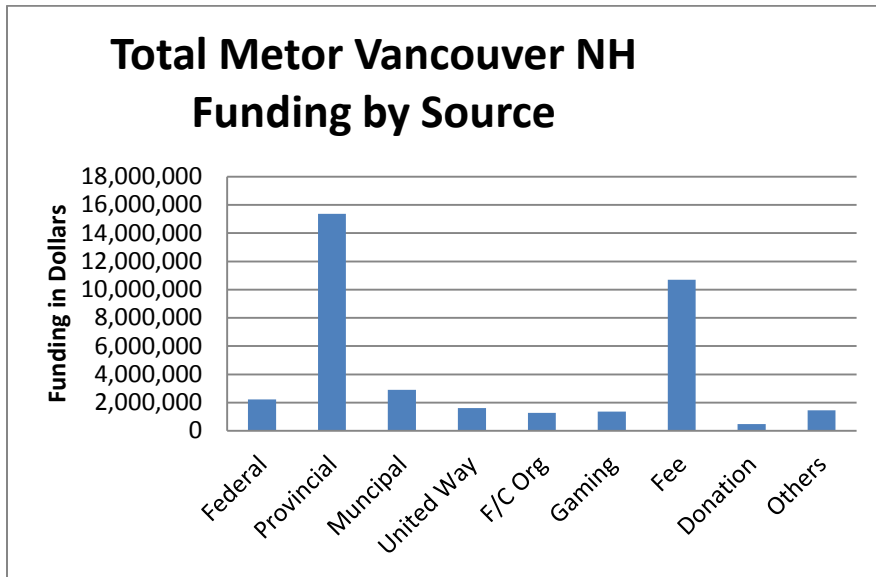
